

ASSEMBLY TIPS

IMPORTANT! PLEASE READ THESE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS IN ENTIRETY BEFORE ASSEMBLING YOUR PRODUCT.

- 1. Find a clean, level surface to begin the assembly of your game table. We recommend that two adults work together to assemble this game. You may want to carefully cut or tear the four corners of the box so that the bottom of the box can be used as your work surface.
- 2. Remove all of the contents from the box and verify that you have all of the parts shown on the Parts List before you begin assembly. **Note: Some parts may be pre-installed or pre-assembled.**
- 3. Some figures or drawings may not look exactly like the product.
- 4. When installing parts that have more than one screw or bolt, hand tighten all screws or bolts in place before final tightening with screwdriver or wrench.
- 5. Electric screwdrivers may be helpful during assembly; however, please set a *low torque* and use extreme caution because screws may be stripped or overtightened, resulting in damaged parts, if the electric screwdriver's torque is set too high.




CARE AND USE



1) Attach the middle connecting piece (F) to half of the leg (A) and tighten the bolts (H) into the proper holes.



Insert screws (H) into the tip of the leg through the four holes. Repeat this step on the bottom of the leg using the same screws (H).

Assembly Tips:

Attention: If you are using an electric screwdriver in the assembly, please set at low torque and do not over tighten the hardware. When assembling individual parts, loosely tighten screws until all screws are inserted, then tighten completely.

Assembly Instructions

NOTE: We recommend that two adults work together to assemble this Billiards Table.

Step 1

Find a clean, level place to begin the assembly of your billiards table. The table will be assembled upside down and then turned over onto its legs once the assembly is completed.


Step 2

Remove all the parts from the box and verify that you have all of the parts as shown on the parts list. Carefully cut or tear the four corners of the box so that the bottom of the box can be used as your work surface.

Step 3


Please insert the LEG END BRACE (#2) and LEG LONG BRACE (#3) onto the table frame as show in below FIG. NOTE: The frame of the table can be pushed by hand to align with the opening of the leg braces for insertion.

Attach the LEG LONG BRACE to the LEG END BRACE using screws (#12) as shown in below FIG.




Step 4

Attach the LEG BRACES to the table frame using the JOINT ANGLE (#14), SCREWS (#11) and SCREWS (#13) as shown in below FIG.



Step 5

Attach the LEG BRACES to the back of the play court using the JOINT ANGLE (#14), SCREWS (#11) as shown in below FIG.





Step 6

Attach the LEG TOP BOARD (#5) and the LEG SUPPORT (#6) to the assembled LEG (#4) using BOLT (#9) and WASHER (#10) as shown in below FIG.

Attached the ASSEMBLED LEG to the LEG BRACES using BOLT (#7) and WASHER (#8)

as shown in below FIG.






CAUTION: Four strong adults are recommended to flip the table as shown.

- 1. Grab the table on the ground.
- 2. Turn the table over.
- 3. Place it on all four feet at the same time on the ground.


Congratulations! You have now assembled your pool table. Please note the Care and Use instructions below to insure many years of trouble free use of your billiard table.

CARE AND USE OF YOUR TABLE

- 1. Use only a slightly damp soft cloth to clean.
- 2. This product is intended for **INDOOR** use only.
- 3. **DO NOT** sit, climb or lean on the table.
- 4. **DO NOT** drag the table when moving it. This will damage the legs.
- 5. **DO NOT** set drinks on the table.
- 6. Use a carpenters level to properly level table using the leg levelers.
- 7. Periodically check all bolts and screws for correct tightness.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR LEVELING A POOL TABLE

- Assemble pool table according to the instruction.
- Any type of level would be sufficient to perform this procedure. However, a two-foot level is recommended.
- Before leveling, make sure level is placed on the playing surface, not the rails.
- Level the ends between the corner pockets: Place the level on the playing surface between the two corner pockets and adjust the height using leg levelers attached underneath the leg apposite of which the bubble in the level favors until the bubbles rests in the middle of the level.



- Repeat the step above to the opposite corner pockets.
- Next, level the length of the table. Place the level next to the side pocket and adjust the height to position the bubble in the middle of the level, using the leg leveler beneath the leg opposite of which the bubble in the level favors.
- Repeat the step above to the opposite length of the table.
- Recheck both short ends to ensure bubble is in the middle on the level.
- Depending on the surface the pool table sits, especially deep pile carpenting, the pool table needs to settle for 24 hours. Recheck the level on each side of the table after 24 hours.

LIFETIME WARRANTY

This product is warranted to the original purchaser to be free from defects in material or workmanship for a period of lifetime from the date of the original retail purchase.
